Dear Homeowner,

Mesa to Mesa is a non-profit organization that provides skilled and volunteer staff and materials to help with minor home repairs. Our goal is to improve the health, safety, and security of homeowners. Homeownership is required and income limits apply. Below is a list of some of the home repairs/modifications we can perform.

repair/replace windows	repair/replace doors	fix holes in walls
replace nonworking locks on doors	fix minor plumbing issues	repair/replace outdoor steps
replace non-working lights	install/replace smoke detectors	patch stucco
repair/replace floors	repair/replace gutters	install grab bars
concrete repairs	repair/replace mobile home siding	repair/replace screens

Mesa to Mesa does not do roof repairs.

In order to qualify you must:

*Have a yearly income at or below the current Federal Poverty Guidelines
